

USING THE TRAIL HOTSPOT



Please note that you must have a **wireless device** to connect to the Trail Hotspot such as a laptop with a wireless card, or an iPhone or Blackberry with Wifi capabilities.

The City is very pleased to provide this **free** high speed wireless internet service; however, City staff are unable to provide any technical support to use the service. Users are directed to contact other resources for technical issues.



In order to connect, you must be at one of the City of Trail Hotspot locations: **Trail Memorial Arena, Trail Aquatic and Leisure Centre, on Bay Avenue, or at City Hall.** Look for the service broadcasting as **"trail-hotspot"**, for example, **"trail-hotspot-aq"** at the Aquatic Centre. Every device is unique in terms of the signal it can acquire. Some devices will pick up a signal inside Bay Avenue businesses while others will not. The closer your device is to Bay Avenue and the Memorial Arena, the better the signal strength. Users are directed to contact other technical support if there are issues with connectivity.

Once you have connected your device to the network then open your web browser. You will be brought to the City of Trail Hotspot Welcome Page as pictured below. Enter the displayed password **"guest"** and click the **Accept** button. You will be brought to the City of Trail website. You are now ready to begin surfing the Internet. By entering the password and clicking ACCEPT you **agree** to the terms and conditions as presented.
